9/13 - 9/14

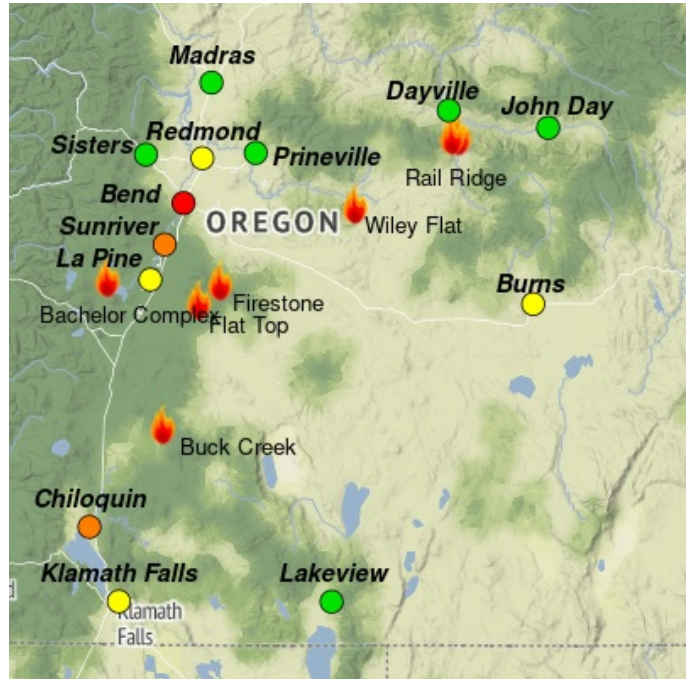

### Fire

Slight potential for fire spread today with warmer temperatures and lower relative humidity. Central Oregon has fire incidents with minimal personnel. Wiley Flat is 29,904 acres 58% contained Rail Ridge Fire is 161,675 acres 18% contained Firestone 8,787 acres 0% contained Flat Top 30,643 acres 0% contained Bachelor Complex 10,333 acres 0% contained Buck Creek 5,062 acres 0% contained.

### Smoke

Poor air quality is reduced to communities closest to fire incidents. Smoke is likely to continue from smoldering material within fire perimeters, as the day warms fire behavior is likely to increase. Expect today's smoke conditions to repeat on Saturday in most communities.
