Salmon Challis Redrock, Garden, Mowitch/Birch


Crews will continue mop-up and securing of all fire perimeters to tuck this fire in for the winter. Fire activity along roadways involves large machinery, personnel, and hazard tree falling operations. Hunters and local traffic should expect vehicle traffic around every corner to prevent accidents.

Smoke

Improved visibility has returned to the mountains and drainages within the main fire areas. High-level regional haze will hang above 7000' for most of the day until the heating of the sun helps lift this layer into the transport winds. Residents in the Cobalt area can expect the overnight smoke to remain trapped until the afternoon with a brief period of improvement. Expect a few hours of very visible smoke and USG surface impacts. As drainages get shaded, smoke will start to pool in these areas again tonight. Smoldering stumps are most visible along Williams Cr, Deep Cr, and locations near Cobalt.

Extended Plans

Forecasts indicate there is limited potential for the return of smoke impacts above MODERATE across the forecast area.
