


















EATON FIRE INCIDENT UPDATE

**Current Situation:** Last night, firefighters responded to multiple service calls and worked to extinguish hotspots around structures. Aircraft were deployed for water-dropping missions along the northeast perimeter near Chantry Flats, where fire growth has been observed. Today the priority continues to be structure protection and fire line construction to increase containment on the East, North, and West flanks.

**Damage Assessment:** Aerial imagery overlays show approximately 7,081 structures may have been damaged or destroyed. The number of structures damaged and destroyed listed at the top of the page are verified by damage assessment teams and will be updated with validated information as it becomes available.

**Weather:** A Red Flag Warning is in effect until 6 p.m. Friday, and a High Wind Warning is in effect until 2 p.m. Friday. Northeast winds will strengthen this morning, reaching 25 mph with gusts up to 35 mph. Ridgetop winds are expected to gust as high as 45 mph during the morning hours. These strong winds will persist through midday, then gradually subside to 12-15 mph in the afternoon. Winds will weaken further during the early evening, before picking up again overnight, with northeast winds increasing to 10-15 mph after midnight.

The entire Angeles National Forest is temporarily closed for public safety and the protection of natural resources from January 8, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. through Wednesday, January 15, 2025, at 12:00 midnight. During this time, the following acts are prohibited within the Angeles National Forest and San Gabriel Mountains National Monument:

- 1. Going into or being upon the Angeles National Forest. 36 C.F.R. § 261.52(e).
- 2. Being on any National Forest System Road within the Angeles National Forest. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54(e).
- 3. Being on any National Forest System Trail within the Angeles National Forest. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55(a).
