National Environmental Policy Act Analysis

Section 102 of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requires federal agencies to prepare detailed statements of major proposed federal actions significantly affecting the quality of the human environment (42 U.S.C. Sec 4332). This closure order is categorically excluded from analysis in an Environmental Assessment or Environmental Impact Statement per 36 CFR 220.6(d)(1): Prohibitions to provide short-term resource protection or to protect public health and safety. This action is consistent with the Nantahala National Forest Revised Land and Resource Management Plan. No additional documentation is required to proceed with implementation of this order.

Social Economic Effects

There are insignificant social economic effects from the proposed closure that could be meaningfully evaluated and that would require analysis.
