CONTAINMENT LINES HOLD AGAINST GORGE WINDS

Rowena, Ore. – Today, crews will continue to work into the fire's interior, extinguishing hot spots and building depth to the black line. Crews will continue to mop up towards the center of the fire, putting out any emerging hot spots and extinguishing any heat they find. Night crews made progress on highway 30 mopping up and improving line so the day crew can continue to build on their progress.

As the Rowena Fire work builds containment and risks decrease, some resources began to demobilize and be reassigned to other emerging incidents around the state. Oregon Department of Forestry will continue to lead the efforts and remain on the Rowena Fire until the team can safely return it to the local district. Winds will continue today and increase throughout the day, causing weakened trees and limbs to be hazardous to work around. Crews will monitor weather conditions as they work in the fire's interior and move to safer work areas if wind speeds become excessive.

Level 1 and 2 evacuation levels remain in effect in the fire area.

The Red Cross shelter remains open at The Dalles Middle School at 1100 East 12th Street. Livestock and horses can be taken to the Wasco County Fairgrounds at 81849 Fairgrounds Road.

I-84 remains open; however firefighters are continuing to work near the roadway; be aware of crews when driving through the area.
