**Willow Creek Fire Area/Trail/Road Closure**

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50 (a) and (b), the following are prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands, roads, and trails in the Greys River and Kemmerer Ranger Districts, Bridger-Teton National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A: Described Area/Trails:

1. Being on the Described Trail. 36 C.F.R. § 261.55 (a).
2. Being on the Described Road. 36 C.F.R. § 261.54 (e)
3. Being upon the Described Area. 36 C.F.R. § 261.52 (e)

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting resource in the performance of an official duty.

**DESCRIBED AREA/ROADS/TRAILS**

**Described Area A:** Defined boundary for area closure is as follows: from U.S. Highway 89 T 29 N R 119 W Section 26 running North along the 032 Trail (Packstring Creek) to the 026 trail (Driveway Creek) T 29 N R 119 W section 17, running north to the 027 trail at T 29 N R 119 W section 05, heading North East along Spring Creek to the 028 trail (Second Creek) at T 30 N R 119 W section 17, heading North East to the 073 road at T 30 N R 119 W section 09, continuing onto the 034 road at T 30 N R 119 W section 10 to the Forest/ Private boundary at T 30 N R 119 W section 03 following the Forest/ Private boundary East to the U.S. Highway 89 back to the point of origin. Smiths Fork Winter Trailhead east of U.S. Highway 89 is also closed. Within the described area, all roads and trails are closed including Allred Flat Campground.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this Order is to protect public safety. Numerous hazards make it unsafe

for public presence in an uncontrolled wildfire environment.

## **IMPLEMENTATION**

1. This Order shall be in effect from September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025, at 0600 through October 14<sup>th</sup> at midnight, unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Area/Trails is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/alerts/r4/alerts-notice>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.
