Castle Area and Road Fire Closure

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551 and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), the following are prohibited on the National Forest System (NFS) lands, roads, and trails in the Tiller Ranger District, Umpqua National Forest, described below and shown on the attached map incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A:

1. 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e) Special closures or restrictions.
2. 36 CFR § 261.54(e) National Forest System roads.
3. 36 CFR § 261.55(a) National Forest System trails.

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with Forest Service Permit No. FS-7700-48 (Permit for Use of Roads, Trails, or Areas Restricted by Regulation or Order), specifically exempting them from this Order or a written determination by a Forest Service authorized officer that a permit is not required under 36 C.F.R. § 251.50(e)(1) or (2).
2. Any Federal, State, or Local Officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

DESCRIBED AREA AND ROADS

Closure Area is described as an area starting at the intersection of Forest Service Road (FSR) 2715 and FSR 2715-950 in T27S, R03W, Section 32, following FSR 2715-950 southeast to Forest Service Trail (FST) 1477, following FST 1477 south to FST 1576A, following FST 1576A south to FST 1576, following FST 1576 south to FSR 3700-870, following FSR 3700-870 southwest to FST 1470, following FST 1470 south to the Umpqua National Forest boundary, following the Umpqua National Forest boundary southwest to FST 1437, following FST 1437 west to FST 1437A, following FST 1437A south to FSR 2900-550, following FSR 2900-550 southwest to FSR 29, following FSR 29 northwest to FSR 2830, following FSR 2830 northwest to FSR 2838-800, following FSR 2838-800 west to FSR 2838, following FSR 2838 north to FSR 28, following FSR 28 west to FSR 2814, following FSR 2814 north to FSR 2715, then back to the point of origin at the intersection of FSR 2715 and FSR 2715-950 in T27S, R03W, Section 32.

FSR 28, from the intersection of FSR 28 and FSR 2814 in T28S, R02E, Section 31, to the intersection of FSR 28 and FSR 29 in T29S, R01E, Section 16

FSR 27, from the intersection of FSR 27 and FSR 28 in T29S, R01E, Section 11, to the intersection of FSR 27 and FSR 2741 in T28S, R01E, Section 27

FSR 2781, from the intersection of FSR 2781 and FSR 2814 in T28S, R02E, Section 19, to the intersection of FSR 2781 and FSR 2781-100 in T27S, R01E, Section 35

PURPOSE

The purpose of this Order is to protect public and firefighter health and safety during active wildfire suppression operations.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order shall be in effect from 7/31/2026 at 17:00PM through 12/28/2026 at 11:59PM, unless rescinded.
2. A map identifying the Described Castle Area and Road Fire Closure is attached and made part of this Order as Exhibit A. For a digital version of this Order and Exhibit A, go to <https://www.fs.usda.gov/r06/umpqua/alerts>.
3. Unless otherwise expressly defined in this Order, the terms used in this Order are defined by the regulations of the Secretary of Agriculture, 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299. If there are terms in this Order that are not expressly defined in the Order or 36 C.F.R. Chapter II, Parts 200-299, their meaning shall be determined by their plain language definitions.
4. A violation of the above prohibitions is punishable as a Class B misdemeanor by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, or by imprisonment for not more than six months, or both. 16 U.S.C. § 551; 18 U.S.C. §§ 3559, 3571, and 3581.

6. This Order supersedes the 06-15-02-26-01 Order prohibiting the same or similar acts in the Castle Area and Road Fire Closure.
